INSTRUCTIONS

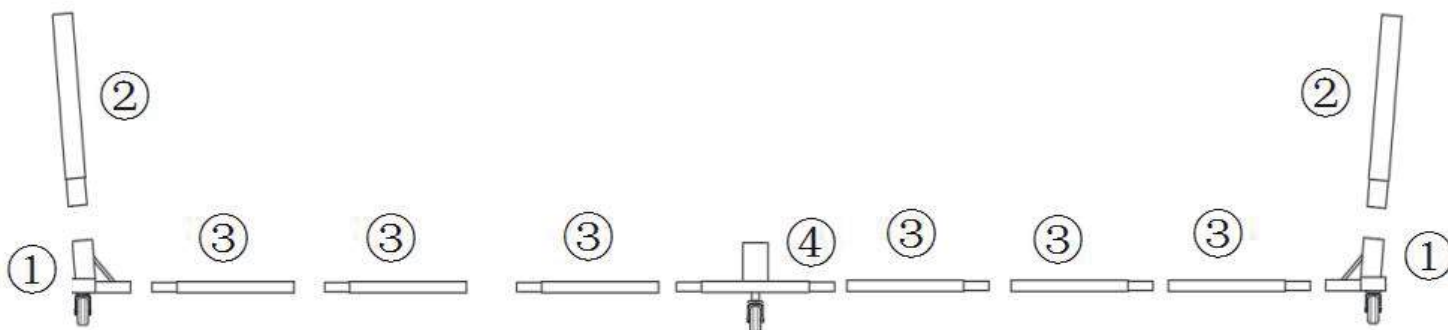
PICKLENET PLUS™ is constructed with durable powder-coated steel and conforms to official Pickleball specifications, measuring 22' x 34" at the center. It features a patented proprietary rectangular center strap design that is the best in the industry and maintains consistent net height during play. Adjustment straps on the net edges provide excellent net tension, while the added integrated wheels allow for easy transport and quick repositioning.

The PickleNet Plus™ assembles quickly and comes with a strong zippered nylon bag with organizing compartments for convenient storage. Additionally, our patented oval tubing is guaranteed not to twist like traditional round frames, ensuring long-lasting stability and performance.

STEP 1

Assemble the horizontal poles first. Use the full net image as a reference (see other side).

STEP 2

Place 2 end bases approximately 22 feet apart. Place center support midway between both end bases. Connect 3 straight poles on each side of the center base.

STEP 3

Insert two vertical net post poles that have end caps into each end base. The frame is now completely assembled.

STEP 4

Slide net sleeves over each vertical net post. Insert patented center strap rod through rectangular opening in center support base. Attach Velcro around small round vertical pole to secure.



STEP 5

Use adjustable net straps to create straight net appearance as shown in photo. To accomplish this, loop black adjustment straps through "D" ring and then back around pole to secure with Velcro at desired tension.

NOTE

Your center strap height should now be at regulation 34 inches off the ground. At one foot inwards from the end of the net on each side, the net height should be a regulation 36 inches. To adjust this height, simply slide the net sleeve up or down as needed.
