All OnCourt OffCourt Court Shapes and Lines are made from our proprietary recipe of materials with the following benefits:

- 1. **WINDY DAYS** The materials set the industry standards in terms of quality, durability, and weight. They are not easily blown around on windy days.
- 2. **DIRT RESISTANT** Our Court Shapes and Lines do not absorb dirt like other similar spots and lines. Other companies' products get permanently stained and lose their vibrant color.
- 3. **LONG LASTING BRIGHT COLORS** Our shapes maintain their brilliant colors for years, far longer than other similar products.

COLD WEATHER CHALLENGE: The only challenge with this material is that it is slightly stiff and should be stored flat, especially in colder weather. Warm weather and warm temperatures are the friends to our Court Shapes. The warmer the temperature, the more pliable the material. If your Court Shapes are "out of shape" and not sitting flat on the tennis court, they just need to be heated to re-establish their original flat shape.

TWO OPTIONS: The two options are to put the shapes under warm/hot water and then let them sit flat as they dry and cool. Or, use a hair blower or something similar.

FINAL NOTE: Users have to understand there is no affordable material in cold weather that will not do this. The answer is to store it flat in cold weather and to get it flat, raise the temperature of the material.
