Your new MultiMower comes in only four parts and assembles easily in seconds. Just follow the photos below to put the cart together. Don't over tighten the locking cylinder for the vertical arms in case you want to take it apart to transport in your car.



The lower tray fits nice and snug on the MultiMower arms with a slide-in bolt keeping it securely in position.



Screw the pipe fitting on each vertical pole to assemble the frame and then hook and slide the top basket into place.



Close the arms as shown to feed balls or wheel through narrow walkways.



Pick up balls with the arms open. Then remove and empty the lower basket. The top basket can always be secured to the MultiMower.



The two small back wheels (one of them is shown in this photo) allow users to tilt and roll the unit over small bumps in sidewalks.



The MultiMower can be easily moved from court to court. Just unscrew the vertical handles into two parts and it will fit into most vehicles for easy transport.
